Operations Progress since the last meeting


- New facility manager

Availability Line 1+2 BY 18/19


Actual and Plan (Plan = Business Plan)


Line 1 and 2 current operations Availability Line 1+2 from Take Over till now Actual and Plan (Plan = Business Plan)



- In the UK we intend to become one of the major contractors delivering Energy from Waste Facilities.








Fatal injuries to workers by main industry




