	Monitoring since the last meeting was carried out on the following dates: - 24th July 2013 - 8th August 2013 - 22nd August 2013 Noise levels varied between 44dB and 62dB Noise levels were found to be still within agreed limits. No significant change in noise levels has been seen with the ongoing works.	
	Noise monitoring sessions have been staggered throughout the day and the order of monitoring receptors has been changed to ensure that a representative range of site activities is captured.

	The demolition of the bridge has been completed and bridge beams are now being installed.	
	Erection of steel work for filters and silos, installation and erection of components and steel work for the boiler are ongoing.	
	Installation of assembled bag filter units has been completed and all four silos have been installed.	
	Limited excavation works around piles and foundations are ongoing.	
	Construction works for floor slabs and walls are ongoing.	
	Acoustic screens are still being used strategically around site as needed. Noise monitoring has been carried out.	
	The building concrete structures are now providing some additional mitigation.
