## SWDWP Waste Contract - Proposed Energy from Waste plant

As you probably know, MVV Umwelt has been shortlisted by South West Devon Waste Partnership for its waste disposal contract to provide an Energy from Waste plant to treat municipal waste in South West Devon.

MVV is one of Germany's leading Energy from Waste companies, with around 5D years experience in building and operating waste management plants in Germany, where it works with 22 local authorities in five federal states.

The company has submitted two proposals to SWDWP, one for a site at Ernesettle and the other at North Yard, Devonport Dockyard. If the company is selected as preferred bidder, it would only develop a solution at one of these sites.

MVV is committed to public consultation. It is holding two public exhibitions next week to give local people the opportunity to view the initial proposals, ask questions and give their comments. Members of the project team will be on hand. We are also holding a preview for elected members at each location, to which you are invited.

The preview at Ernesettle will be held from **3 – 4pm on 8<sup>th</sup> February**, and at Weston Mill Community Primary School from **4.30 – 5pm on 9<sup>th</sup> February**. If you are unable to make either of these previews, you are of course more than welcome to attend the public sessions.
