

Current PCC Vehicle usage at Camel's Head and Carlton Terrace / Ferndale Road Junctions

Description:

The Camel's Head and Carlton Terrace / Ferndale Road Junctions are located in a peripheral area of the city as far as waste collections are concerned. There are only two days per week when household waste is collected in the area: Wednesday for St. Budeaux and part of Ham; Thursday for Ham. There are 4 residual crews in St. Budeaux on a Wednesday and 5 residual crews in Ham on a Thursday. However, not all crews will operate in the vicinity of these junctions and use alternative routes to tip at Chelson Meadow depending upon where the vehicle is full or the round terminates. This is shown below for the residual waste rounds only.

Every other week there will be a recycling collection and garden waste collection (for 7 months of the year) and these are intended to continue as per current arrangements and will not be affected by new EfW facility location.

The Trade Waste services customers in the area of both junctions and collects both residual and recycling twice per week and will use both junctions on a pass-through basis as part of their round.

In addition there will be ad hoc collections for missed bins and bulky waste which average about once per month.

The St. Budeaux bring banks are serviced by a skip lorry using the A38 St. Budeaux interchange and Victoria Road. Weston Mill HWRC is serviced from the St. Budeaux interchange so doesn't use either junction. These will continue as per current arrangements and will not be affected by new EfW facility location

Camel's Head Junction:

Currently the crews generally use Victoria Road or Roman Way and the A38 at the St. Budeaux interchange. However, when collecting around the Wolseley Road area they will use the Camel's Head junction to access the A38 so pass through both junctions.

There are approximately 10 waste related vehicles passing through the Camel's Head Junction per week – mainly on a recycling / garden waste week and Monday to Friday.

Carlton Terrace / Ferndale Road Junction:

The following table details the use of the Carlton Terrace / Ferndale Road Junction. The table includes the use of the vehicles that also use the Camel's Head junction to access the A38 so represents a composite analysis.

The St. Budeaux vehicle will approach the junction from the Carlton Terrace side whilst the Ham and trade vehicles will approach from the Ferndale Road side.

The ad hoc vehicles could use either side depending upon the properties they have been given.

There are approximately 24 waste related vehicles passing through the Carlton Terrace / Ferndale Road Junction per week – mainly on a recycling / garden waste week and Monday to Friday.
