Industry and Suppliers Day

MVV Environment Devonport Ltd is holding an Industry and Employment Day in Plymouth to encourage local industry and job seekers to make contact and explore opportunities for working jointly in the South West Devon Waste Partnership (SWDWP) project. Subject to achieving planning permission, MVV will start construction of an Energy from Waste plant with combined Heat and Power at HM Naval Base, Devonport in 2012. MVV has signed a contract with SWDWP to build, operate and maintain the plant for the next 25 years.

What is the event about?

The project will require a wide range of goods and services, ranging from canteen services to engineering and construction, and office materials, transport services and accommodation. People who are seeking jobs with MVV or its subcontractors can also attend. Local businesses and interested individuals are invited to come along to meet MVV and its partners, to find out what they need. There will be no charge for attending the event.

The day will focus on the construction phase of the project but MVV will also be open to discussions about possible services and jobs during the operational phase.

The event will be held in the Baylis Suite. There is free visitor parking available at Tamar Science Park but you will need to give your vehicle registration number to the main reception. 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Who will be there?

MVV will be present with representatives from its main subcontractors. Details of the companies, their specialisms and a brief summary of their requirements are given below. For a full breakdown of the services required and the jobs available, download a complete list from the website.



MVV is responsible for the plant design and construction, employing a variety of international and local subcontractors to achieve this. MVV will also be the long-term operator of the plant once built. MVV will have a range of employment opportunities, including engineering, finance and contract managers and plant operators. Services required will include car and plant hire, cleaning, catering and maintenance.



Envi Con & Plant Engineering is the general designer and will have engineering jobs.



Kier Construction is the civil engineering contractor and will have engineering and administration jobs (CPSC card essential) and require ancillary services.



LAB will provide the Air Pollution Control equipment and will require a range of mechanical and electrical equipment.



SAR is the electrical power and control supplier and will require, eg, fire detection, lighting protection, CCTV and telephone systems.



Standardkessel Baumgarte is the boiler and grate supplier and will require contractors and tool hire services.



Imtech is the water steam cycle supplier and will require steelwork fabrication and installation.



Sutco will supply baling equipment.

How to make the most of the event

So that suppliers and visitors can gain maximum benefit from the day, MVV and its main subcontractors have prepared information showing what kinds of services and jobs are required. Visitors are requested to download this information to evaluate which exhibitors they would like to meet. This scheme will provide up to 300 jobs during construction, as well as 33 permanent jobs during operation, with a further 70 indirect jobs, such as in contracted plant maintenance. MVV will be investing 250 million Euros in the project, with significant spin-off benefits for the region. The scheme will only go ahead if MVV receives planning permission from Plymouth City Council.
