3 in Baldovie, a state of the art energy from waste combined heat and power facility. After a four-year build, due to weather and COVID-19 pandemic delays, the team were elated when the facility successfully completed all commissioning tests at the start of 2022. The curtain fell to reveal the modern artwork which complements other pieces in the city of Dundee. The success of the day is testament to the dedication and hard work of the team, as well as demonstrating the true partnerships with our customers, partners, and contractors. The new energy from waste facility will process approximately 110,000 tonnes of waste per year, providing an environmentally sustainable waste treatment solution for Dundee City Council and Angus Council by keeping residual (non-recyclable) waste out of landfill.

The team celebrated the official opening of the new Line




GOOD NEIGHBOURS GROUP 2023


