





## MEB Energy from Waste Combined Heat and Power Facility (EFW CHP) Site Visits

We welcome visits to the Baldovie EFW CHP facility where over 370 lorries deliver waste every week which is then burnt at temperatures of more than 1000°C to generate useful energy in the form of electricity and steam.

These visits are free of charge and there is parking available on the car park opposite the Baldovie Scrapyard, at the end of Forties road. There is an absolute maximum of 12 people per site tour, but groups may book more than one visit if interest exceeds this.



## Your visit

You will be met on arrival at the weighbridge, signed-in to the visitor book and shown to our conference room. The visit will commence with a safety briefing and overview presentation about the company, this project and wider waste issues; pitched at a suitable level for your group. Following this there will be a comfort break and appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) will be provided for the site tour.

The site tour includes a visit to the tipping hall, waste transfer station, control room, the boiler and turbine hall to view the waste fire.

Please allow at least one hour for your visit. Technical groups may need longer as our staff are always happy to answer questions during the tour. Please see contact details at the end of this information sheet.







## Health and Safety

- Every precaution has been taken to ensure the safety of our visitors, who will receive a health and safety briefing at the start of their visit; it is important that any children in the group are accompanied by a responsible adult and that they listen to all instructions given.
- All visitors must wear long sleeves, trousers and sensible enclosed footwear; any visitors not wearing the required clothing will not be able to take part in the site tour
- All visitors will be provided with the necessary PPE, this will include a hard hat, safety glasses and a high visibility vest; these must always be worn in the correct manner as instructed.
- Any visitor with height concerns must be forewarned that the site tour includes a visit to the boiler platform which requires walking on metal mesh flooring through which ground level can be seen.
- The Community Liaison Manager reserves the right to end a visit at any time if they feel that any health and safety considerations have been breached.

Relevant paperwork including risk assessments will be provided to the lead contact upon confirmation of a booking.
