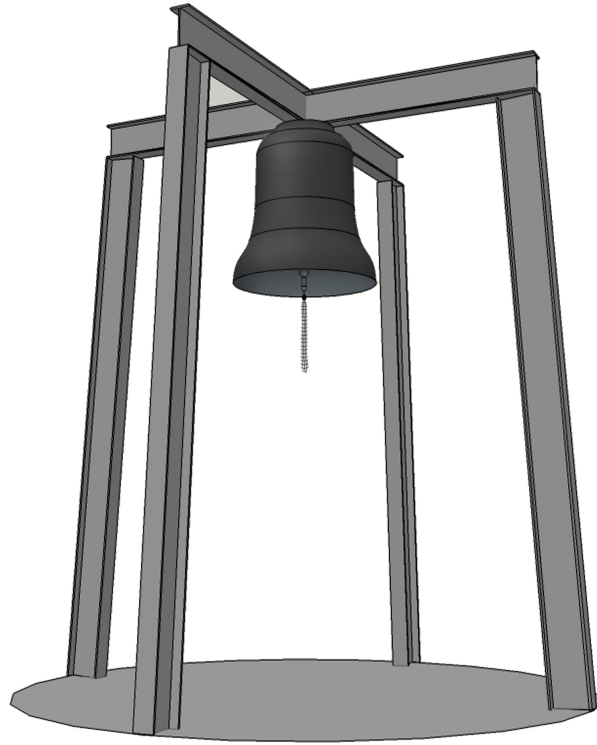


An artwork about time, place, communication, and transformation.



Before mass communication bells were widely used as a call to action, a marker of time, to call communities together, and to commemorate important events. Born of the discarded materials of our everyday lives; the piece represents and marks a change in thinking as we look towards a better, more sustainable future.

Over a period of six months waste metal will be collected from Devonport EfW facility. This material will then be re-melted and cast as a working bell at the world renowned John Taylors Bell Foundry.

Bell measurements: 80 x 80 x 86cm

Overall steel structure measurements: 300 x 300 x 320cm
