Here are some highlights from the last year:

- Over 4000 people visited site for waste education and site tours.
- We held a record-breaking open day with over 350 people in attendance and
 180 of them taking up a site tour.
- 48 local schools came to visit and participate in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathmatics) related activities.
- A resource pack was made and shared with teachers for British Science Week.
- 25 Community Groups came for more technical site tours.
- We held our annual Clean Our Creek event in October 2022.
- Our Community Liaison Manager attended and hosted various community litter pick events.
- We continue to work with Pollenize, hosting an apiary and supporting their research into bee behaviour, moths and biodiversity.
