
## Appendix 1 Operations Progress since the last meeting

- Two new appointments






## Line 1 and 2 current operations Availability Line 1+2 BY 18/19 Actual and Plan (Plan = Business Plan)



\* Planned outage moved from October to August/September as concerted




## Line 1 and 2 current operations Availability Line 1+2 from Take Over till now Actual and Plan (Plan = Business Plan)
